Policies and Information for Transports

Below is a summary of information to help you and your horse through the transport process. Each trip is an individual experience and we want it to be a positive experience for you and especially for your horse. We have included some frequently asked questions to help ease you through the process.

Dates and Timing:

Our dates are for the pick-up portion of the trip and not for delivery, delivery dates can change based on distance, weather conditions, and construction delays. We do our best to go door-to-door with your horse in a timely fashion.

We will call you the night before a transport to touch base with you on your readiness and horse's condition.

We do not do nightly layovers (on cross county trips) unless there is a problem with equipment or a horse. In the event of a breakdown, horses are stabled at our expense.

Vet Work required in order to ship:

A health certificate is required for horses being transported across state lines. Check with your local vet on specific diseases to vaccinate against including a Coggins test. If your horse is traveling out West, you must have a Brand Inspection or Hauling Card (proof of ownership, not proof of a brand) has to be done by the state licensed brand inspectors for horses leaving western states.

Insurance:

Brian West Enterprises, Inc. and Brian & Beth West is not an insurer of your horses condition. We do not own your horse and therefore cannot buy insurance for it. If you wish to purchase an insurance policy to protect your horse from injury, mortality, colic, loss of use or any other instance, you must obtain it.

On a Trip:

We will stop every 3-5 hours to check the horses for food, water and safety. We ask that you provide a Bale of Hay to be used for your horse during the trip, and if the trip is a longer one, water from the tap they are use to drinking from. We will provide the containers for the water.

Leg Wraps, Head Bumpers, Blankets, etc. are the responsibility of the owner.

Letter of Authorization: Must be obtained before we can transport your horse.
